

Santagiuliana Way from Island Street to South Street

A concrete bikeway that has a few slight gradients. It runs alongside and through patches of coastal forest. This walk is a memorial to Eddie Santagiuliana, a former mayor of the Redlands. The Santagiuliana Way runs from South Street in Thornlands to the Cleveland railway station but this description covers only the section between Island Street and South Street. Suitable for bicycles.

Return distance: 4.6 km

Return time: 1 hr to 1 hr 30 min

Starting Point: The walk starts at the end of Island Street. [UBD Map 206 Ref A1](#). [Redlands Community Telephone Directory Map 5 Ref D7](#).

The route as far as Carolena St is shown on the Redlands and the Brisway maps.

There is limited parking at the start.

Public Transport: Bus Routes 274 and 275 run from Cleveland Rail station to McLeod St and then into South Street. Call Translink on 13 12 30 or visit their website at www.translink.com.au for more information.

Description of Walk

Follow the concrete path from the parking place for about 100 m to where there is a shelter. Go to the right here (The left branch goes to Oyster Point which is 1.3 km away). The path skirts the Henry Ziegenfusz sports fields before reaching a long section of boardwalk that passes through coastal forest. When the path reaches the second section of board walk, a short path goes off to the right to an interesting memorial to Eddie Santagiuliana.



The path turns sharp left at Goleby Esplanade and shortly afterwards passes an enormous Moreton Bay fig tree. The route climbs onto the point (Cape Cleveland) from where there is a view eastward over the southern Bay and also to the north to the channel alongside Cassim Island where the ferries pass on their way to and from Stradbroke Island. The path continues on the top of the rise and round in front of the houses before descending on a timber walkway. It then runs behind the mangroves for a short distance before ending 100 m south of the end of South Street. Return the way you

came.

Facilities

Island Street end: Shelter, seating and water at the start, benches at intervals along the path

South Street end: Children's' play area, water

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
